Thank You

Road Safety

Road safety within our school community is an important responsibility recognized by the school. Together with parents we share the responsibility for road safety education. It is therefore vital that there is a consistent adherence to road safety rules and procedures.

It would be appreciated if parents would kindly refrain from doing **U-turns** in Leicester and Derby Road as this disrupts the flow of traffic and therefore puts our learners at risk.

Learner's lunch

Just a reminder that learners **MUST NOT FORGET** to bring a packed lunch from home. Parents **MAY NOT** bring in lunch for learners.

Learners must bring their own water bottles to school. **NO** learner may drink water directly from a tap.

Arrangements for Term 4 school attendance – Intersen Phase

We will continue with the one day in, one day off in Term 4, until we hear contrary from the GDE. When school re-opens on 2 November, **Group 1** will come in on **Monday, Wednesday and Friday** and **Group 2** will come in on **Tuesday and Thursday**. Grade 7 learners will be at school every day.
