As we enter term four the "final stretch" of 2025, I encourage everyone to strike a balance between maintaining your academic rigour and taking care of your well-being. With final exams on the horizon, it's crucial that you stay focused, organized, and disciplined in your studies while also making time for rest and reflection.

I trust that over the holidays, you've had an opportunity to reflect on your goals and progress you have made this year. Now is the time to put that reflection into action.

As we approach the last few weeks of this year, I wish all students, staff, and families the best of luck. Let's finish the year with a 100% pass rate.

SCHOOL FEES:

Dear Parents,

Our school is proud to offer quality education, safe facilities, and enriching activities — but this is only possible through your support. School fees are not optional; they are essential to keep our school running.

When fees are unpaid, the school cannot afford necessities like:

- Toilet paper and cleaning supplies
- Printing paper and learning materials
- Textbooks and stationery
- Sports and extra mural activities

If this continues, we may need to ask parents to provide these items directly, and unfortunately, we may have to cancel sports and extra murals, reduce learning resources, and limit school events.

We understand that times are tough, and we are here to help where we can. But we ask that you please prioritize your school fees — for the sake of your child's education and the future of our school.

HOMEWORK FOR INTERSEN PHASE LEARNERS: (i.e. Grades 4 to 7)

The greater majority of our learners do their work well and hand it in on time. They bring great pleasure to their educators! However, some Intersen Phase educators have been experiencing difficulty getting some of the weaker learners to apply themselves diligently. We appeal to parents, who are aware that their children are weak and irresponsible, to become involved in their school work. Please follow up daily the homework written in the school books to ensure that your children achieve the standard of competency required for promotion at the end of the year. Our ongoing advice to our learners is: **DON'T JUST DO IT DO IT RIGHT.** Homework and projects will, as always, be carefully planned to enable our Intersen Phase learners to be prepared for their weekly tests. (Children are assessed continuously throughout the year.)

A Good Daily Procedure Especially for Grades 4, 5, 6 and 7 Learners:

- 1 Do homework according to the homework diary and the following day's timetable. Have your parents check and sign.
- 2 Check the day's timetable for other matters requiring attention, e.g. sports kit for Physical Education lessons.
- 3 Empty suitcase daily and pack it according to the timetable for the next day.
- 4 Leave at home all books which are not required.
- 5 Prepare tog bags and extra-mural kit for the next afternoon's activities too.
- 6 Thank your parents/family for what they do for you.

ENROL YOUR CHILDREN NOW FOR GRADE R:

Parents of children, who require Grade R in 2026, should ensure that their application for admission to our Grade R class is completed timeously. Grade R is for children turning six in 2026. Grade R is run privately by the School Governing Body. Therefore, no fee subsidies will be granted.

EXAMS:

These will be held from Monday, 17th until Monday, 24th November 2025. If any children are absent during this time, a doctor's note is compulsory. **EXAM TIMETABLE TO FOLLOW.**

Preparation for Exams (Controlled Tests):

Have you, as a parent, prepared your children for the exams (Controlled Tests)? Please spend time with your child and check the following:

1. He/she is doing revision every day.
2. Ensure that the exam timetable is visible in a prominent place.
3. Also ensure that the study scope is visible.

COLLECTION OF CHILDREN AFTER SCHOOL:

Our school day ends at 14h00 Monday to Thursday and 12h35 on Fridays. The only children who should still be at school after this time are those **legitimately taking part in an extra-mural activity**. It has come to our attention that some children are being left to wait at the gate very late! Have you considered the following?

- It is not fair on your child – especially in the cold/hot weather.
- It is not necessarily always safe for your child to wait alone.
- Boredom usually leads to trouble.
- If an accident occurs – who is there to give assistance?

When you enrolled your child/children at Leicester Road Primary, you signed the consent forms agreeing to get your child/children to school on time and to collect them after school on time. Please be considerate and adhere to this agreement.

EXTRA-MURAL ACTIVITIES – SLIP SLAP SLOP (SUN PROTECTION):

The extra-mural programme for the fourth term commences this Monday. Some days we experience brilliant sunshine and heat. We, therefore, recommend that our learners:

- Slip on a school sport shirt – which has a high collar.
- Slap on a Leicester Road School cap or hat – preferably with a wide brim.
- Slop on sun protection cream – especially on the face, neck, hands and arms.

We appeal to parents to ensure that all physical education and swimming outfits (including towels) are clearly marked with learners' names. We also ask parents to help their children pack their cases on the days they have these activities. Our office becomes inundated with items which have been 'left at home'. We are trying to teach learners responsibility and organisation skills and would appreciate it, if you could help us in this regard. An organised learner is a happy learner. Please ensure that your children (boys and girls) bring a cap for swimming. Children should also be reminded to drink water throughout the day. Extra Murals start on Monday, 20th October 2025.

Our Parents evenings will take place for all grades on **Wednesday, 22 October 2025** from 16h30 until 18h30. Letters for invited parents have been sent out already, please check with your child if they received one.
